EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES	<p>mobility exchanges You can apply for an Erasmus exchange programme if you are studying at a European university that has a bilateral exchange agreement with La Cambre Arts visuels.</p> <p>International You can apply to study at La Cambre Arts visuels for up to two semesters if you are an international student studying at one of our partner institutions.</p>
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS	<p>Academic You must have completed at least one year of university and have a good academic record.</p> <p>Language requirements Most of practice studios are English friendly. However, the main teaching language is French. A sufficient knowledge of French or English is therefore expected. French language courses for international students are available and free during their stay at La Cambre.</p>
HOW TO APPLY	<p>You must apply through your home institution.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Confirm your institution is a La Cambre partner. Your home University must have an exchange agreement with La Cambre Visual Arts. La Cambre will only consider applications that are sent by our partner universities. 2. Students must be officially nominated by their home institution. La Cambre will not consider any direct application by students. 3. Apply to La Cambre <p>To complete this application, you will need several documents :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3.1 Application form (to be downloaded from our website www.lacambre.be, then signed by your academic tutor and the Erasmus coordinator at your home university) 3.2 Electronic portfolio (pdf only, A4 format) 3.3 Personal statement 3.4 Photocopy of ID card or passport 3.5 An ID photograph <p>Please return the signed application form with all supporting documents to your home institution's exchange Coordinator, who will forward it to La Cambre Arts visuels at erasmus@lacambre (if too heavy for a regular email, please use WeTransfer).</p>
THE APPLICATION DEADLINES	<p>For Semester 1 (September 2019–January 2020): April 19, 2019</p> <p>For Semester 2 (February 2020–June 2020): November 15, 2019</p>
ADMISSION	Admission to La Cambre is validated by the relevant department's academic staff after examination of the application and depending on available places. A note of acceptance will be sent by email to the student and his/her exchange coordinator within a month after the application deadline.
FEES	Students accepted as part of an exchange programme don't pay registration fees, as their school of origin had paid for their tuition.
CREDIT SYSTEM (ECTS)	At the end of their studies at the ENSAV La Cambre, exchange students receive an attestation as well as a transcript of grades and credits corresponding to each teaching unit. The average workload for one semester at La Cambre is 30 ECTS (60 ECTS for the whole academic year). However, the incoming student's Learning Agreement should include at least 20 ECTS.
ACCOMMODATION	Our school does not have on-campus accommodation. To help students find accommodation during their stay in Brussels, we send them before they arrive a list of websites with offers for shared apartments rentals.
