

## Incoming students procedure

EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES	<p><b>mobility exchanges</b> You can apply for an Erasmus exchange programme if you are studying at a European university that has a bilateral exchange agreement with La Cambre Arts visuels.</p> <p><b>International</b> You can apply to study at La Cambre Arts visuels for up to two semesters if you are an international student studying at one of our partner institutions.</p>
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS	<p><b>Academic</b> You must have completed at least one year of university and have a good academic record.</p> <p><b>Language requirements</b> Most of practice studios are English friendly. However, the main teaching language is French. A sufficient knowledge of French or English is therefore expected. French language courses for international students are available and free during their stay at La Cambre.</p>
HOW TO APPLY	<p><b>You must apply through your home institution.</b></p> <p>1- Nomination To apply for the exchange programme, students must be nominated by their home institution. The exchange programme coordinators at partner institutions receive the information directly around March for the autumn semester and September for the spring semester. This step can be completed through the following <a href="#">link</a>.</p> <p>2- Application Applicants will receive a link to the application platform. Individual responses will be sent within four weeks of the application deadline. There is no automatic admission of nominated students. Professors will review applications, and students will be admitted mainly depending on the quality of their portfolio. Studio space may be in limited supply. Student applications may be declined for this reason.</p> <p>3- Documents required to prepare your application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electronic portfolio (<i>only in pdf</i>)</li> <li>• Letter of motivation (<i>only in pdf</i>)</li> <li>• Curriculum vitae (<i>only in pdf</i>)</li> <li>• Photocopy (front and back) of your identity card or passport (<i>only in jpeg</i>)</li> <li>• Passport photograph for your student card (<i>only in jpeg</i>)</li> </ul>
THE APPLICATION DEADLINES	<p>For Semester 1 (September – January ): April 20</p> <p>For Semester 2 (February – June ): October 20</p>
ADMISSION	Admission to La Cambre is validated by the relevant department’s academic staff after examination of the application and depending on available places. A note of acceptance will be sent by email to the student and his/her exchange coordinator within a month after the application deadline.
FEES	Students accepted as part of an exchange programme don’t pay registration fees, as their school of origin had paid for their tuition ; however, some departments may charge for consumables and/or small equipment.
CREDIT SYSTEM (ECTS)	At the end of their studies at the ENSAV La Cambre, exchange students receive an attestation as well as a transcript of grades and credits corresponding to each teaching unit. The average workload for one semester at La Cambre is 30 ECTS (60 ECTS for the whole academic year). However, the incoming student’s Learning Agreement should include at least 20 ECTS.
ACCOMMODATION	Our school does not have on-campus accommodation. To help students find accommodation during their stay in Brussels, we send them before they arrive a list of websites with offers for shared apartments rentals.
